REQUIREMENTS TO GRADUATE WITH HONORS (optional)

- Overall GPA of 3.0 or higher; average GPA of 3.5 or higher in the major
- BA paper (25-30 pages) written in French, due no later than Friday of 5th week in Spring Quarter of 4th year. Students are encouraged to take FREN 29900. BA Paper Preparation during Winter Quarter of 4th year. **BA paper is only required if student wishes to qualify for honors.**

**Ten courses beyond FREN 20300 are required. No courses in the major can be counted toward general education requirements. Courses must be taken for quality grades and no more than 3 courses may be taken out of residence. Students must complete a substantial part of the course work (e.g., readings, writing) in the appropriate Romance language in order to receive credit. Deadline for program approval: Spring Quarter of 3rd year. See College Catalog for full program requirements.*
