- \* Basque, Catalan, French, Haitian Creole (Kreyòl), Italian, Portuguese, or Spanish
- \*\*Students writing a BA honors paper may include a BA Paper Preparation course or Academic Research and Writing course as one of their literature and culture courses.

- Remaining courses may be selected in consultation with the relevant undergraduate advisers
